We understand that there may be many questions about the transition from Commercial Bank to PremierBank. It is our desire to fully communicate to customers and staff the steps which will be taken to transfer Commercial Bank customers over to PremierBank.

We want this process to be as simple and seamless as possible.



WHY? *The answer is simple.*

We will be a better community bank together. One of the strategic visions of PremierBank is to be the leading, locally-owned bank in the communities in which we operate. Combining with Commercial Bank allows us to keep pursuing that goal and expand what we already do well in other communities.

Furthermore, scale and efficiencies matter in community banking today. We will be able to serve our current and future customers better together through investments in technology, spreading out regulatory costs and operating more efficiently.



August 9th (Closing) to September 22nd

It will be business as usual. The banks will operate under their current banners: ***PremierBank and Commercial Bank.***

During this time frame PremierBank will be working with Commercial staff to plan the transition and bring the two organizations together.

August 9th – 18th:

You will receive mailings from both Commercial Bank and PremierBank. Please watch for these as they will contain specific information regarding your deposit accounts, debit cards, loans, etc. and anything you need to do as part of the transition.

September 23rd – 24th:

During this weekend, the data conversion will take place and the combining of the two banks into PremierBank will occur.

Commercial Bank locations will be closed Saturday, September 23rd. Commercial Bank ATMs will be available but your transactions may be limited.

All 10 locations will open on Monday, September 25, 2017 as PremierBank.

Checking, Savings, and Money Market Accounts:

We will review all accounts to determine if any account numbers are the same as current PremierBank account numbers. If any duplicate numbers exist, we will work with those customers to establish new account numbers.

In September when the banks are combined, all Commercial customers will be issued new checks, at no charge, since the bank routing number will be changed from Commercial Bank to PremierBank. Any outstanding checks will be rerouted to PremierBank after September 25th.

Debit Cards:

If you currently have a Commercial Bank Debit Card, you will be issued a new PremierBank Debit Card in September with instructions of how and when to activate these cards.

Direct Deposits and Automatic Withdrawals:

Commercial Bank customers will have to notify any company that they have setup for automatic direct deposit or withdrawals (such as payroll, Social Security or automatic payments) since the routing number will be changing. However, PremierBank will be acquiring the Commercial Bank routing number and will keep it active until December 31, 2017 thus you will have an extended period of time to get this completed. The effective date of the change must be on or after September 25, 2017. Please contact the Bank if you require assistance with this process.
